Format:

- First Kick off: 9am
- Limited to 16 Teams – 10 players per squad (7 a side).
 - 3 games Guaranteed in Pool Play.
- Teams aim to qualify for the post section play in the Championship, Plate or Consolation knockout rounds.

Prizes:

- Certificates for every player
- Awards for Winners and Runners up of each post section knockout finals.
- Individual medals for Top Goal keeper, Top Defender, Top Attacker and Best and Fairest Award.

Cost: \$100 per team. (\$10 per player).

Papakura City FC 9th / 10th Grade Tournament Competition Rules - 2010.

General.

- All girls only teams can play in the grade below their age, if they wish to. Eg. 10th grade all girls can play in 9th grade section or the 10th grade section.
- Time keeping is the responsibility of the host Club. All pool and semi final games will start and stop, on the hooter. Finals will be to the referee's time keeping.
- Please be ready with your team to go on as soon as the game before has finished.
- Referees are to be supplied by the host club.
- Referees decisions are final. The results recorded on the referee's game card are final.
- 7 a side with up to 3 substitutes.
- Size 4 balls.
- Field size approx 60m long by 40m wide with junior size goals.

Rules.

- FIFA Rules.
- Two yellow cards, or a red card in any game during the tournament will mean a stand down of one game for that player.
- Any yellow or red cards will not be carried over past the tournament, or referred on, unless it is a matter of serious misconduct or violent behaviour, in which case it will be referred to Auckland Football Federation.
- With regard to dispensated players. Only those players that have **officially** been granted dispensation by their parent Federation and who are playing with their **regular** team may participate.
- Spectators and supporters should be along the sidelines. No one is to stand behind the goal lines.
- All players must wear boots and shin pads.
- The referee's decision is final.
- Rolling substitutes when the ball is out of play, with the referees consent.

Scoring

- 3 points for a win
- 1 point for a draw

Pool play

12 minutes - each way – 1 minute for half time.

In the event of even points at the end of pool play, final positions will be decided by:

1. Highest goal difference
2. Highest goals for
3. If goal difference is the same and their game was drawn in pool play then highest corners for.
4. If still undecided then toss of a coin.

Post Section Knockout

1. Quarter / Semi Finals are 12 minutes each way with 2 minutes for half time.
2. Finals are 15 minutes each way with 2 minutes for half time.

If two teams are tied after full time in post section knockout play, the result will be decided by:

1. 5 minutes of extra time with the golden goal rule. Teams change ends from when they finished normal time and the first team to score a goal wins.
2. If neither team scores in extra time, we move to sudden death penalties. That is, if the first team's player, scores and the opposition team's player - misses, then the game is over.
